The question today is, how can this man Jesus give us life? then what things, activities and people make our life better?


What are the most important things for life? Choose 3 from this list by drawing a circle around the words...

In the reading today Jesus says he gives life. When you read this reading can you count up the number of times you read the word life, living, live or lives? (you should get the answer 10.)

Jesus said to the people, 'I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Anyone who eats this bread will have eternal life. The bread that I will give for the life of the world is my body.'



But the people argued among themselves 'How can this man say that? How can he give us his body to eat?'

Jesus replied, 'I am telling you the truth; unless you eat my flesh and drink my blood you will have no life within you. Whoever eats and drinks this will live for ever, and I shall take them to God at the end of time. My flesh is true food and my blood is true drink.'

He continued, 'Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, * lives in me, and I live in them. Just as the Father sent me and I draw life from the Father, so whoever eats me will draw life from me. * This is what I mean by the bread that has come from heaven; not like the manna that your ancestors ate, and they died. * Anyone who has this bread inside them will live for ever.'
